Main findings in the year 2004-05

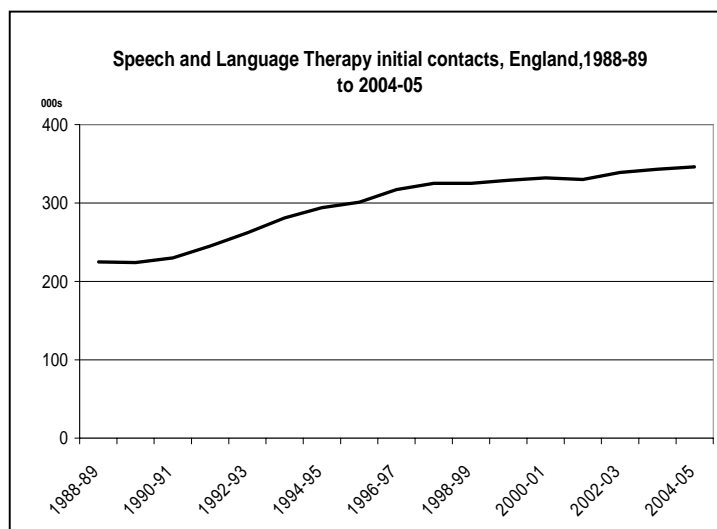
- The number of initial contacts (new episodes of care) was 346 thousand, 1% more than in 2003-04 and continuing the very gradual upward trend seen since 1996-97.

1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 The information in this publication, about patient contacts with NHS Speech and Language Therapy staff in England is collected on Department of Health annual return KT29. A copy of the KT29 is at the end of this summary.

1.2 Nine trusts were not able to provide information about their Speech and Language Therapy services for 2004-05. All other trusts known to provide a service made a return for 2004-05, although a few returns were incomplete. Estimates have been made of the missing data (see 3.4 below).

1.3 The KT29 return was discontinued from



April 2005 and this publication is the last in this series.

1.4 Population estimates for mid-2004 have been used in calculating rates for tables 4 and 6.

2 COMMENTARY

2.1 Initial contacts (Tables 1, 2, 3 and 4)

2.1.1 The number of initial contacts (new episodes of care commenced in the

year) with Speech and Language Therapy staff was around 225,000 from 1988-89 to 1990-91 and then increased steadily by an average of about 5% per year until 1997-98 when the number of initial contacts was 325,000. The number has since risen to 346,000 in 2004-05, about 1% more than in 2003-04, see chart.

2.1.2 Overall 41% of episodes were initiated

by referrals from Hospitals, mainly from consultants in General medicine, Geriatric medicine and Ear Nose and Throat specialties. Of non-hospital referrals, about 14% were from Health Visitors, the remainder coming from a variety of community sources.

2.1.3 Of the new episodes, 58% were with males. About 38% of the new episodes were with school age (5 - 15) or pre-school (age 3 or 4) children.

2.1.4 The rate of new episodes per 1000 population varied considerably by age: there were 55 episodes per 1000 for children aged 3-4, 18 per 1000 for those aged 0-2 and 17 per 1000 for those aged 5-9. The lowest rates were for the 16-54 age group (1 per 1000) but rates were high for those aged 75-84 (18 per 1000) and 85 and over (42 per 1000). In all age groups, other than 16-54, the rate for males was higher than the rate for females.

2.2 Strategic Health Authority data (Tables 5 and 6)

2.2.1 Initial contact rate per thousand population varied considerably between strategic health authority, from 4 per thousand in County Durham and Tees Valley to 12 in North Central London. A similar range was seen for each age group.

2.3 Provider level data (Table 7)

2.3.1 Selected information about initial contacts with each provider's service is shown in Table 7. It includes a percentage breakdown by age group at the time of the initial contact.

2.3.2 Provider trust codes shown next to the provider names in Table 7 distinguish NHS Trusts (Rxx) from Primary Care Trusts (5xx) and Care Trusts (Txx).

3 DEFINITIONS

3.1 An **initial contact** is the first in a new episode of care with a service provider.

A new episode of care may be initiated by a referral to the Speech and Language therapist from a hospital, GP or other health service professional. Where a previous episode of care for the same patient did not end with a positive discharge from care, a new episode is recorded only if more than 6 months have elapsed since the last contact.

3.2 A **face-to-face contact** is any meeting between a Speech and Language Therapist and an individual patient or patient's proxy, where treatment or advice is given. The collection of face-to-face contacts was discontinued from 1 April 2000.

3.3 A **first contact** is the first time a patient is seen in the financial year by Speech and Language Therapy staff. A subsequent contact with a different member of staff employed by the same service provider does not count as a first contact. First contacts are the number of

different persons receiving care in the year as each patient is recorded only once in any year by any provider. The collection of first contacts was discontinued from 1 April 1993.

3.4 Where a provider is unable to submit a return, data from the latest available year are used. Where parts of a return are missing, the corresponding parts from the latest available year are used, scaled as appropriate.

ADDITIONAL GUIDANCE NOTES

DEFINITIONS

1. An **initial contact** year is the first in an episode of care with a service provider and is the number of new episodes of care in the year. An episode of care may be initiated by a referral to the Speech and Language Therapist from a hospital, GP or other health service professional. Where a previous episode of care for the same patient did not end with a positive discharge from care, a new episode is recorded only if more than 6 months have elapsed since the last contact.
2. The total in Part 1 must be the same as the total in Part 2.

SOURCE OF REFERRAL DATA

3. The need to specify details of the source of referral of initial contacts from hospital specialties has proved difficult in the past owing to space limitations in the return and no formal provision for this. Details for the source of referral for the main hospital specialties in connection with this return should be entered in Part 1. A continuation sheet is provided at page 4 listing the additional specialty function codes necessary for this return. Please use this continuation sheet for all specialties other than those shown in Part 1. The total for the continuation sheet should be entered in Part 1 against the box "other".
